Open to registered mares and geldings four years old or over. Not exceeding 122cms. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bit, the leading rein to be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. (Riders must not have attained their 9th birthday by 1st January in the current year). SP/SHP ponies in this class will NOT qualify for the NPS Finals.

# Class 34 - M&M/ SHOW PONY/SHOW HUNTER PONY FIRST RIDDEN. Including NPS M&M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER Qualifier – 3 highest placed M&M FR within the top 6 to qualify.

M&M ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book.

Open to registered mares and geldings four years old or over. Not exceeding 128cms. (Riders must not have attained their 12th

birthday by 1st January in the current year). SP/SHP ponies in this class will NOT qualify for the NPS Finals.

NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2024.

The NPS General Rules for Showing apply (see NPS website for details).

In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2023/2024 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2024 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

#### **IMPORTNANT INFORMATION - Your personal data**

Exhibitor you will need to provide the WPCS with certain personal information relating to you. Your privacy is extremely important to WPCS, so we want you to know exactly how we will use that personal information. Our full privacy notice setting out detailed information about matters such as what personal information we use, for what purpose we use it, what our legal basis for doing so is and who we share your personal information with, can be viewed on our website http://wpcs.uk.com/ If you would prefer to see a hard copy of our privacy notice, please ask a member of WPCS staff to provide you with the same.

#### This show is affiliated to the Welsh Pony and Cob Society. Affiliation No AF000127.

Animals must be entered correctly in line with the rules, detailed in the WPCS Judging and Showing Handbook which can be found on the Society website www.wpcs.uk.com or requested from the WPCS office. Failure to comply with the rules may result in the withholding of awards.

#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

- 1. The Organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, accident or injury to Person, Animal or property.
- 2. The Judge's decision is final. All objections must be lodged in writing to the Secretary, within half an hour of a class. A deposit of £25 must accompany the objection and will be forfeit if the objection is not upheld.
- 3. All equines in medal classes must be registered with the W.P.C.S.- except foals unless they are 6 months old.
- 4. The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate classes if less than three entries are received.
- 5. Kings RC request 12month flu vaccinations.
- 6. All foals at foot must be over three weeks old. All weaned foals must be 5 months old or over.
- 7. Exhibitors must check and follow the stated rules on impartiality for their class as to whether they can exhibit under the judge on the day of the show.
- 8. All trophies and cups remain the property of the Association and must be returned in good condition and in good time for the next year's show.
- 9. Whips and Canes No shaft of any whip or cane shall exceed 75cms (30 inches).
- 10. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to present their exhibit at the ring on time for their class, not the responsibility of the announcer.
- 11. A brood mare is a mare that has produced a foal, live or dead (vets certificate required) in the <u>current</u> year, all other mares are classed as barren.
- 12. Ridden Welsh Classes are run under WP&CS Rules unless otherwise stated.
- 13. All Ridden Equines must be 4 years old or over.
- 14. Animals, 3 years old and under including foals must not be body clipped for showing purposes.

Long hair under the jawline and those protruding from the ears may be trimmed off leaving as natural a line as possible. The whiskers around the muzzle MUST NOT be trimmed.

- 15. All colts/stallion 2yr and over must be bitted and lead by a handler that is 14 or over on the 1<sup>st</sup> of January in the current year
- 16. All handlers under the age of 14 must wear a British Standard Hard Hat, gloves and suitable footwear.
- 17. Riders of stallions 13.2hh and under must be 12 years old as of 1<sup>st</sup> January and riders of stallions over 13.2hh must be 14 years of age as of the 1<sup>st</sup> of January.
- 18. Entry fees will not be refunded without a Veterinary Certificate
- 19. If the show is cancelled all entry fees will be returned unless the show is rescheduled then no fee's will be returned.
- 20. The committee reserve the right to ask a competitor to leave the ring if he/she is seen to be showing cruelty or abuse to their animal.
- 21. No bags or other forms of noise aids are not to be used around the rings, please have respect for other competitors. Anyone who continues after the first warning will be asked to leave and any future entries will be refused.
- 22. The bronze status of the show will be verified by the WPCS after the event and if the requirements of the WPCS rules are met, the society will issue the correct awards. Any questions relating to the status of the show must be made direct to the WPCS Office. enquiries@wpcs.uk.com
